Apr 15

Women Legislators of Missouri Scholarship: \$500; for female seniors; must be a Missouri resident. Students must exhibit leadership and community service and must respond to an essay no more than 500 words. Applications available in the Guidance Office.

Apr 15

Delta Sigma Phi (Mizzou): two \$500 awards; for any non-Greek male attending Mizzou in the fall. Applications will be considered based upon but not limited to academic success, ACT, school involvement, community activities, and leadership roles. Applications available in the Guidance Office.

Apr 15

Cape Girardeau Evening Lions Club Calvin R. Wells Scholarship: \$250; 2.5 minimum GPA; must demonstrate good character, school and/or community involvement, potential to succeed, and the desire to become a useful citizen; one recommendation letter. Applications are available in the Guidance Office.

Apr. 15

Robert C. Byrd Scholarship: \$1,500 per year for four years; must be resident of MO, score in top 10% on ACT, rank in top 10% of class, and file with selective service; www.dese.mo.gov

Apr 20

American Legion Lillie Lois Scholarship: two awards of \$1000; one to a boy who has attended Boys State; one to a girl who has attended Girls State; must be Missouri resident

Apr 20

American Legion MD "Jack" Murphy Memorial Nurses Training Fund: one \$750 award; for anyone training to become a Registered Nurse; must be in top 40% of class and have "C" or better average; must be resident of Missouri

Apr 20

American Legion Joseph J. Frank Scholarship: five awards of \$500; given to descendants of veterans and must have attended Boys or Girls State; must be resident of Missouri

Apr 20

American Legion Charles L. Bacon Memorial Scholarship: two awards of \$500; must be a member of the American Legion, American Legion Auxiliary, Sons of the American Legion, or a descendant of a member of any of those organizations; must be Missouri resident

Apr 20

American Legion Erman W. Taylor Memorial Scholarship: two awards of \$500; must be planning on obtaining a degree in education; must be a descendant of a veteran who served 90+ days of active duty w/ honorable discharge (proof of discharge necessary); be a Missouri resident; submit essay of no more than 500 words on "In your opinion, what was the most significant world even of 2007/2008?"

Apr 20

American Legion Shane Dean Voyles Scholarship: *only one student may be nominated from Notre Dame;* \$500 award; student selected on the basis of athletics, scholastic and leadership abilities; must be involved in community and school activities; must intend to be a full-time student at an accredited college/university. Applications are due to Mrs. Mueth for selection by April 12th.

Apr 23

SADD National College Scholarship: ten scholarships \$500 each; student must enroll full-time during the 2010-2011 academic year; must be a U.S. resident; must be dedicated to living the SADD lifestyle (safe, substance-free, etc.); and must be in a registered SADD chapter. Members of the SADD National Student Leadership Council are not eligible. Two recommendation letters and personal statement required. Hi-Tech Communications, Inc. Scholarship: \$500; for students desiring to enter the field of technology and have been accepted to a vocational or two to four year school. Two letters of recommendation in addition to the application are required. Applications are available in the Guidance Office and *must be received by the deadline.*

May 1

Cape Girardeau County Rotary: \$1000; must have at least a B average (3.0); have a record of participation in extracurricular activities; demonstrate commitment to community service; work experience is also considered. Applications are available in the Guidance Office and *must be received by the deadline.*

May 17

Balanced Man Scholarship: for males only; must be attending Murray State University as a freshman; for men who strive to achieve balance and all-around excellence; minimum 20 ACT; www.sigepmsu.com
