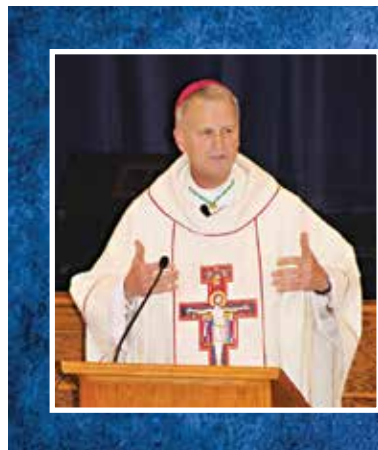
I want you to know that your generosity and prayers continue to make this school the sacred place that it is today.

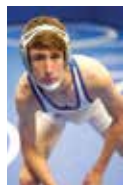
Three State Players For Girls Golf
