FINANCIAL INFORMATION 2019 - 2020

Tuition:

Catholic: \$5,916.00 per year (\$493.00/month for 12 months, beginning in June)
(Active membership in a parish that subsidizes Notre Dame)

Catholic: \$6,681.00 per year (\$556.75/month for 12 months, beginning in June)
(Membership in a parish that does not subsidize Notre Dame)

Non-Catholic: \$7,791.00 per year (\$649.25/month for 12 months, beginning in June)

International Students: \$8,493.00 per year (Payable annually or semi-annually)
- One time I-20 processing fee of \$50.00

Actual cost of educating a student at Notre Dame is \$8,493.00.

The stated TUITION amount includes all fees with the exception of:

Activity Fee (all students): \$100.00 (**Will be invoiced with book fees**)

Includes: Booster Pass; Home & School Fee; Bus Fee

Graduation Fee (Seniors only): \$100.00 (**Will be invoiced with book fees**)

Retreat Fee (Juniors only): \$100.00 (**Will be invoiced with book fees**)

Registration Fee (current students): \$125.00 (**Paid in February for returning students**)

Registration Fee (incoming freshman & transfer students): \$125.00

Processing Fee (transfer students): \$50.00 (**In addition to the registration fee**)

Parents may wish to make monthly, quarterly or semi-annual payments, or make one payment. These intentions should be indicated on the TUITION CONTRACT.

Tuition payments must be up-to-date **BEFORE** transcripts, records or diplomas will be released.

Application for TUITION ASSISTANCE is available by contacting the Principal at 573/335-6772. Tuition Assistance applications must be returned to the Principal by May 31, 2019.

Other Expenses:

All *consumable* workbooks, Notre Dame High School student planner, Guidance testing, online courses, retreats, and other supplies will be invoiced after the 1st day of school. These materials must be paid for by December 10th and are listed as separate line items on the invoice. English I and II paperback books may be used from a prior sibling with approval from the instructor. If your student does not have the English paperback books, they can be purchased from the library at the time they are needed for class. Book/miscellaneous fees are due by December 10, 2019.

A subscription to the Hi-Lites, the school newspaper, is included in the tuition amount. Purchase of a class ring and the annual Silhouette yearbook are voluntary.

Lunches - A point of sale system is used in our cafeteria. There will be a variety of menu options and la carte items available for the students. The lunch charge per week will be approximately \$20.00 (this includes 1 restaurant day @\$5.00/day per week).
